Subject: HIT AND RUN CRASH INVESTIGATION

On May 5, 2020, at approximately 9:30 p.m., City of Miami Police officers responded to a hit and run crash involving 4 vehicles at the intersection of N. Miami Avenue and 36 Street.

Once police officers arrived, preliminary investigation revealed that a Ford Mustang traveling northbound on N. Miami Avenue crashed into a Subaru traveling westbound on N.W. 36 Street. One of the occupants of the Subaru was ejected and the other two victims suffered serious injuries. The occupants and drivers of the other vehicles involved, the Toyota SUV and the Chevy SUV, were not hurt. According to witnesses, before police arrived, the driver and occupant of the gray Ford Mustang had fled the scene on foot.

Two seriously hurt victims were transported to Jackson Memorial Hospital via Miami Fire Rescue. The ejected victim was pronounced deceased on the scene.

Detectives need assistance on locating the driver involved.
