Traffic Homicide Detectives conducted a thorough and extensive investigation to identify the vehicle and driver responsible for the hit-and-run crash that killed **Koritza Ortiz**. As a result of their investigative efforts, **Rodrick Leon Davis Jr, D.O.B. 04/10/1992**, has since been arrested and charged with **Leaving The Scene of A Crash/Death**. On June 9, 2025., at approximately 8:09 a.m., Miami Police officers responded to the area of NW 7th Avenue and 60th Street in reference to a hit-and-run traffic crash involving a pedestrian.

Upon arrival, officers discovered an elderly female, lying unconscious at the scene with visible injuries. Miami Fire Rescue responded and pronounced the victim deceased.

At this time, the victim has been identified as **Koritza Ortiz, D.O.B. 02-16-1949**.

The Miami Police Department's Traffic Homicide Unit is actively investigating the circumstances surrounding the crash, including identifying the vehicle and driver responsible.

Investigators are urging anyone who may have witnessed the incident or who has information that may assist in identifying the suspect to come forward.
