- The streets shall reopen by 1:00 P.M.

- Start south on Biscayne Blvd
- Right on SE 4th Street
- Right on SE 3rd Avenue
- Left on SE 2nd Street
- Right on SW River North River Drive
- Right on NW 5th Street
- Right on NW 3rd Court
- Left on NW 3rd Street
- Left on NE 2nd Avenue
- Right on Biscayne Blvd Way
- Right on Biscayne Blvd-Finish
