Miami Police is investigating a burglary that occurred on Wednesday, July 24, 2019, at 1400 N.W. North River Drive.

According to detectives, the victim stated that she left her office between the hours of 1:00 p.m. through 2:00 p.m. At approximately 5:00 p.m., the victim realized her purse that was kept in her desk drawer was missing. Contained inside of the victim's purse was her firearm and other personal credentials.
