Subject: SHED BURGLARIZED

Miami Police are investigating a residential burglary that occurred at approximately 5:20 a.m. on Thursday, September 2, 2021, from a shed located behind a home at 555 N.E. 73 Street.

According to detectives, the victim reported an unknown subject burglarized her shed by breaching her front gate. Video surveillance depicts the subject making his way to the backyard where the victims' tool shed is located. Several seconds later, the subject can be seen leaving the premises with a yellow-colored duffle bag. After the victim assessed her tool shed, she observed miscellaneous items were stolen.

Suspect: Male, approximately 35-45 years of age, weighs approximately 140-150 lbs, stands 5'7" – 5'8", medium built, last seen wearing a gray hat, red long sleeved shirt with a black shirt underneath, black long pants with light colored sneakers.
