Subject: HOME INVASION ROBBERY

The City of Miami Police Department's Robbery Detectives are investigating a home invasion that occurred at 2028 N.W. 18 Terrace on Sunday, December 8, 2019, at approximately 4:00 p.m.

According to investigators, the victim, who resides in the home was outside tending to his dog when he was approached by an unknown subject (subject #1) who was armed with a folding knife and demanded for him to re-enter his home and find him some money. Once inside, the victim walked towards one of the bedrooms with the subject at which point in time he began to ransack the room searching for money; however, he was unsuccessful.

A second victim who resides in the home was in the backyard at the time of the incident and overheard his dog barking in an unusual manner. Once he made it to the front yard, he observed a suspicious silver colored vehicle parked in front of the home. He then attempted to confront the driver (subject #2) who produced what appeared to have been a firearm and pointed it at him before fleeing from the scene.

He attempted to follow behind the driver in his vehicle and noticed subject #1 jumping the fence, running away from his property. The driver was then observed picking up subject #1 at N.W 21<sup>st</sup> Avenue and N.W. 18<sup>th</sup> Terrace and was last seen fleeing eastbound from the location.

No injuries were reported during the incident.

**Suspect 1:** White male, 5'7 to 5'9, possibly in his 20's, weighing 170 to 180 pounds. Last seen wearing a green t-shirt, blue jeans, possibly white Jordan sneakers, wearing a camo ski mask and black gloves.

**Suspect 2:** Driver. No other description available.

**Offending vehicle:** Possible 2017 C 230 Silver Mercedes with dark tints and a paper tag.
