Subject: POLICE INVOLVED SHOOTING

Today, Tuesday, June 25, 2019, at approximately 9:15 a.m., Miami Police officers responded to a residence located in the 300 block of S.W. 37 Avenue reference a domestic violence call.

According to investigators, once officers arrived, they located a male suspect at which point one of the officers was forced to discharge his firearm.

The male suspect was pronounced deceased by medical staff at Jackson Memorial Hospital's Ryder Trauma Center.

An injured female victim who was located by officers was transported to Jackson Memorial Hospital's Ryder Trauma Center where she is currently listed in stable condition.

The Florida Department of Law Enforcement is investigating.
