MALE PHYSICALLY ATTACKED

Miami Police are investigating an assault that occurred at approximately 6:00 p.m., on Sunday, July 5, 2020, at 875 N.W. 42 Avenue.

According to detectives, the victim was at the counter purchasing coffee at the incident location when an argument ensued with another subject at the window counter over compliance for wearing masks. The argument escalated quickly and within seconds the subject, along with several other accomplices began physically attacking him.

The second victim, who is the girlfriend of victim one awaited in the car at the time of the incident; upon realizing that he was being assaulted she immediately ran to his aid and was hit during the scuffle.

Detectives reviewed video surveillance which corroborates the statements provided by both victims.

Detectives are looking for:

Suspect 1: White male, approx.. 25 – 30 years of age, 5’9, weighing approx.. 190 lbs. Last seen wearing a black shirt with blue jeans.

Suspect 2: White male, approx.. 25 – 30 years of age, 5’7, weighing approx. 220 lbs. Last seen wearing a gray t-shirt and black shorts.

Suspect 3: White female, approx.. 20 – 30 years old, 5’3, approx.. 190 lbs. Last seen wearing a black shirt and blue jean shorts.

Suspect 4: White female, approx.. 25 – 30 years old, 5’6, approx.. 150 lbs. Last seen wearing a blue shirt with blue jeans.

Offending vehicle: possibly a red and/or blue Hyundai Elantra or Sonata.
