Subject: **MALE WOUNDED AFTER DRIVE-BY SHOOTING**

On Monday, July 6, 2020, at approximately 6:30 p.m. Miami Police responded to a call of a male shot at N.W. 21st Court and 37th Street.

According to detectives, once officers arrived on scene, a male who suffered from a gunshot wound to his chest was located just in front of the incident's location front entrance area.

Video surveillance depicts a vehicle traveling southbound within the area, reverses and then stops alongside the victim as he's walking. Within seconds, the vehicle can be seen fleeing from the area as the victim begins to run northbound while holding his chest.

Miami-Dade Fire Rescue responded and transported the victim to Jackson Memorial Hospital's Ryder Trauma Center in stable, but critical condition.

Detectives are investigating leads and motives into the shooting; and ask that anyone with information to contact Miami-Dade Crime Stoppers or email Assaults@miami-police.org.

Suspect(s): Unknown description.

Offending vehicle: possibly a Royal Blue 2011-2015 Nissan Versa (no tag).
