Subject: ARGUMENT AT LOUNGE LEAVES ONE PATRON SHOT

The suspect, Pablo Guzman DOB: March 10, 1975 is in custody. U.S Immigration and Customs Enforcement (I.C.E) special agents apprehended Guzman on February 11, 2010, after he landed in Panama City from Cancun, Mexico. On February 12, 2010, ICE special agents in coordination with U.S Customs, Boarder Protection (C.B.P), and F.B.I., escorted Guzman from Panama to the United States to face charges on attempted murder.

Today at approximately 4:30 AM, an argument ensued between patrons inside of "Mia at Biscayne" restaurant/lounge, 20 Biscayne Boulevard.

The argument continued on Flagler Street right after the patrons left the lounge. One of the individuals involved in the argument pulled out a firearm and shot the victim multiple times. The victim was transported to Jackson Memorial Hospital's Ryder Trauma Center in serious condition.

A uniformed police officer, who observed the incident unfolding, discharged his firearm at the offender. It is unknown at this time if the offender was struck. The offender, who is described as a White male approximately five foot nine, fled the scene in a black Mercedes four door, possibly a C-230 model and with possible window damage.
