Subject: **MALE HOSPITALIZED AFTER SHOOTING**

On Monday, June 29, 2020, at approximately 2:30 p.m., Miami Police responded to a Shot Spotter alert at 320 N.W. 71 Street.

According to detectives, upon the arrival of police personnel, a male victim was observed lying on the ground suffering from apparent gunshot wounds.

Miami Fire Rescue responded to the scene and transported the victim to Jackson Memorial Hospital's Ryder Trauma Center where he remains intubated.

Detectives are looking for:

Suspect 1: Black male, approximately 18 – 26 years of age, black hair. Last seen wearing a white face mask, neon colored yellow shirt with dark jean shorts.

Suspect 2: Black male, slim built, approximately 18 – 26 years of age. Last seen wearing a face mask, black shirt and khaki pants.

Offending Vehicles: Possibly a White Nissan Altima or Maxima.
