## MALE SHOT

On Saturday, August 1, 2020, at approximately 1:30 p.m., Miami Police responded to a Shot Spotter alert in the area of 247 N.W. 51 Street.

According to detectives, once officers arrived on scene, they located a 17 year-old male who suffered from apparent gunshot wounds to his leg and chest area.

As officers continued their investigation, it was determined that the victim was sitting on the porch when a vehicle (possibly Blue Nissan) drove by and began firing gunshots, striking the victim. Two additional individuals who are the victim's family members were inside of the home at the time of the incident. Neither were injured.

Miami Fire Rescue responded on scene and immediately transported the wounded victim to Jackson Memorial Hospital's Ryder Trauma Center.

**Suspect:** (unknown description).

**Offending Vehicle:** Possibly a Blue Nissan 4-door Sedan.
