Subject: MAN SHOT AND FOUND ON SIDEWALK



Today, at approximately 4:30 A.M., Miami Police officers responded to 985 Southwest 5th Street, after learning through a 911 caller that a man who had appeared to have been shot was laying on the ground.

Once officers arrived, they found a man who seemed to be suffering from gunshot wounds laying on the sidewalk.

Miami Fire Rescue immediately transported the victim to Jackson Memorial Hospital's Ryder Trauma Center where there, he underwent emergency surgery and is currently listed in stable condition.

According to the detectives, unknown persons confronted the victim at 1012 SW 4 Street, pointed guns, striking him numerous times. It appears the victim ran away from the initial scene and collapsed in front of 985 Southwest 5th Street.

Miami Police are in search of the shooters. Thus far, the motive behind the shooting remains unclear.
