MAN ARRESTED IN 2014 SEXUAL ASSAULT CASE

The Miami Police Department's Special Victims Unit has made an arrest in a 2014 sexual assault cold case.

On January 1st, 2014, a woman reported being sexually assaulted in the area of NW 12th Avenue and NW 35th Street. The victim stated that she was attacked by a man who dragged her into a wooded area, where she was beaten and sexually assaulted.

Special Victims Unit Detectives have been investigating this case and have identified **Julio Alvarenga, born January 26, 1976**, as the suspect of this violent sexual assault. The Felony Apprehension Team (FAT) searched for Alvarenga and quickly took him into custody.

The investigation is ongoing.

This case highlights the department's commitment to solving crimes and holding perpetrators accountable. The Miami Police Department urges anyone with information about this case or other crimes to come forward and report it to the Special Victims unit at 305-603-6300.
