BARRICADED SUBJECT AND OFFICER-INVOLVED SHOOTING

On Thursday, October 16, 2025, at approximately 8:27 p.m., the Miami Police Department received a report of a man pointing a gun at another man at 400 NW 3 Court.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with a witness who stated the suspect pointed a gun at him and his father. While officers were interviewing the father in their apartment, they were informed that the suspect was still inside and armed. As officers announced their presence, the suspect emerged with the firearm. There was an exchange of gunfire between the subject and officers. No one was injured. The suspect then barricaded himself inside.

After hours of negotiations, the subject surrendered at approximately 2:30 a.m. and was taken into custody without injury. The suspect has been identified as 64-year-old Frederick Norman Kelch.

The investigation is ongoing.
