Subject: **RESTAURANT BURGLARY**

Detectives are investigating a burglary that occurred at approximately 2:00 a.m. on February 25, 2020 at 1971 N.W. 17 Avenue.

On February 25, 2020 the victim flagged down an officer to report that her business had been burglarized. The victim stated that the night prior she observed the suspect laying down on the side of her restaurant and asked him to leave the premises. When the victim returned the next day, she noticed that the rear shed was burglarized. She also had video footage from her surveillance cameras and stated that the suspect was the same person she asked to leave the premises the prior night.

The video footage shows the suspect forcing open the shed doors. The suspect is then seen carrying several cleaning and cooking supplies and tossing them over the fence. In total over \$300 in supplies were stolen.

Detectives are working the case and need assistance in identifying the suspect.

Suspect: White male, 35 – 50 years old, with short black hair, last seen wearing a black t-shirt with white letters, a black ball cap, blue jeans, and sneakers.
