## **TWO SUBJECTS ARRESTED IN NARCOTICS OPERATION**

On Thursday, April 17, 2025, the Miami Police Special Investigations Section, Narcotics Unit, in collaboration with the Miami Dade Sheriff's Office, DEA, City of Miami's PSD, and State Attorney's Office, conducted an all-day narcotics buy-bust operation. The operation resulted in the arrest of two individuals, **Jose Andres Reyes** and **Jose Benjamin Corujo**, for Armed Trafficking in Cocaine.

The arrests took place at a shopping center parking lot located at NW 57 Avenue and 7 Street. A search warrant was subsequently executed at 2364 NW 31 Street, leading to the seizure of multiple firearms, narcotics, and other contraband.

### **\*Seized Items\***

- 10 rifles, including an AK-47
- 3 revolvers
- 181.2 grams of cocaine
- 484.7 grams of marijuana
- 6.5 grams of oxycodone
- 0.7 grams of Adderall
- 0.6 grams of Xanax
- \$782.00 in cash
- Ammunition and magazines

Both subjects were found to be in violation of their probation, with Reyes previously charged with Attempted Felony Murder with a Deadly Weapon and Corujo charged with Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer.
