Subject: **CAMILLUS HEALTH CONCERN BUILDING BURGLARY**

Detectives are investigating a burglary that occurred at approximately 10:55 a.m. on October 13, 2020 at Camillus Health Concern Building located at 336 N.W. 5 Street.

At approximately 10:55 a.m. on October 13, 2020 the Risk Management Manager received telephone calls from the alarm company advising her that alarms were set off in several locations throughout the building. On October 14, 2020 when employees reported to work, they noticed several items were missing.

Building surveillance video was obtained and a suspect is seen walking throughout the building, checking for unlocked doors, and going through desks. The suspect is also seen jumping over a counter.

Among the missing items were two laptops worth over \$3,000.

Detectives are working the case and need assistance in identifying the suspect.

Suspect: White male, slim build. 5'07" – 5'09", 130 – 150 lbs., medium length brown hair, clean shaven, last seen wearing a gray t-shirt, black jeans, black sneakers with white soles, and a black backpack.
