MAN ARRESTED IN STABBING CASE AND SUSPECTED IN FRAUD

On Monday, March 3rd, 2025, at approximately 10:25 a.m., Miami Police Officers responded to a disturbance call at 600 block of N.W. 62nd Street. Upon arrival, officers found the victim bleeding profusely from his left eye.

The victim stated that he was attacked by a suspect, later identified as 39-year-old Youself Megahed. The victim was transported to Jackson Memorial Hospital Ryder Trauma Center for treatment.

Through surveillance footage and eyewitness accounts, detectives identified Megahed as the suspect. He was apprehended on Tuesday, March 4th, 2025, in the area of NW 15th Avenue and 28 Street and transported to the City of Miami Police Violent Crimes Unit for questioning.

A search warrant executed at Megahed's residence uncovered a multi-colored checkered shirt with suspected dry blood, matching the description of the clothing worn by the suspect during the incident.

As the investigation continues, Megahed is suspected in several cases of Real Estate Fraud in the Miami area. Detectives urge anyone who's had interactions with Megahed to please contact the **Miami Police Economic Crimes Unit 305-603-6280**.

Once again, this shows the commitment and dedication of the City of Miami Police Department Detectives to identify and capture anyone committing a violent crime in the City of Miami.
