POLICE INVOLVED SHOOTING

Today, March 8, 2022., City of Miami Police units conducted a traffic stop in the area of N.W. 10th Avenue and 71st Street at approximately 4:40 p.m.

Upon approaching the occupied vehicle, it was determined that one of two subjects was armed with a handgun. A struggle ensued at which point the officer was forced to discharge his firearm. A handgun has since been recovered on scene.

One subject was pronounced deceased on scene, while the other was placed into police custody.

The identity of the deceased is being withheld until next of kin notifications are complete.

The Florida Department of Law Enforcement will be taking lead in the investigation with the assistance of our Homicide Unit and Internal Affairs Section.
