SUPERINTENDENT'S 5K CHALLENGE 2022

The Superintendent's 5k Challenge will take place on Saturday, March 5th, 2022. The race will commence at 7:30 a.m. in Museum Park. The participants will travel north on Biscayne Boulevard to N.E. 11th Street, then east on the MacArthur Causeway to Watson Island. The participants will then travel the same route back to Museum Park. The estimated attendance is approximately 3,000 runners/walkers.

- Traffic will be able to cross on an intermittent basis.
- Drivers in the area should expect delays.
- The street closure(s) and counterflow will begin at approximately 5 a.m.
- The on ramp onto 395 East from Biscayne Boulevard at N.E. 11th Street, will be closed intermittently for the safety of the participants.
- Motorists are encouraged to take alternate routes if they need to travel in the vicinity.
- City of Miami police officers will be placed along the closure for high visibility purposes and pedestrian/traffic assistance.
- Streets will re-open for vehicular traffic at approximately 10 a.m.
