Subject: **SOUTH BEACH TRIATHLON**



The South Beach Triathlon will take place on Sunday, April 19, 2015. It will commence at 6:45 AM in Miami Beach. The bicyclists will travel west on the MacArthur Causeway to the Biscayne Boulevard exit to North Bayshore Drive, north on North Bayshore Drive to NE 14 Street. They will continue west on NE 14 Street to NE 2 Avenue, then travel north on NE 2 Avenue, to NE 36 Street. They will go east on NE 36 Street onto the Julia Tuttle Expressway and continue east back into Miami Beach, where they will return west on the Julia Tuttle Expressway to the Biscayne Boulevard exit and continue west to NE 2 Ave where they will travel north to NE 51 Street, and U-Turn and go back south on NE 2 Avenue to NE 14 Street. They will then continue east on NE 14 Street to North Bayshore Drive, south on North Bayshore Drive onto the I-395 ramp and continue east on the MacArthur Causeway back into Miami Beach.

Street closures are as follows:

- The street closures will begin at 6:00 AM.
- NE 36 Street will be closed eastbound from NE 2 Avenue. The adjacent streets south and north of 36 Street will be open.
- NE 2 Avenue will be closed from NE 14 Street to NE 54 Street.
- NE 14 Street will be closed from NE 2 Avenue to North Bayshore Drive.
- Miami-Dade Transit buses that normally travel along NE 2 Avenue will be re-routed. Please check with Miami-Dade Transit Agency.
- Motorists are encouraged to take alternate routes if they need to travel in the vicinity. City of Miami Police Officers will be placed along the closure to provide assistance.
