Subject: **THIEVES SWITCH FAKE RINGS FOR REAL ONES**



On November 16, 2013 at approximately 4:30 P.M., two women posing as interested jewelry clients entered the Buchwald Jewelers, Inc. located inside the Seybold Building at 36 Northeast 1 Street #12B.

According to the on-scene investigation, the two female suspects approached the store clerk and pretended to be attracted to some rings in the display case. The store clerk began to show them the rings. In about ten minutes, the duo managed to exchange two phony rings for real ones. The two stolen diamond rings are valued at \$10,000.00. Their heist was caught on camera!

**Subject #1** is a described as a 5'6" tall, heavy-set black female with glasses. She was last seen wearing a white dress with pink sweater and carrying a black purse.

**Subject #2** is a described as a 5'9" tall, heavy-set black female with dark sunglasses. She was last seen wearing a blue dress and carrying a black purse.

**Surveillance video is available today**, at the Miami Police Department's Public Information Office, from 3:30-5:00 PM, and to be recorded from the computer monitor.
