Arrest Made in School Campus Break-Ins

City of Miami police officers arrested 66-year-old David Sharon (DOB 06/21/1958) in connection with a series of burglaries targeting vending machines located on educational campuses throughout the city.

On the morning of June 17, 2025, a City of Miami police officer observed an individual who matched the suspect description shared among patrol units. The individual was later confirmed to be *David Sharon*, who was ultimately detained and taken into custody without incident.

At the time of the arrest, six (6) active burglary cases were being investigated, all following a recurring pattern of unauthorized entry onto school property, forcibly pried vending machines, and stolen cash. Surveillance footage, physical evidence, and distinctive clothing helped link the incidents to a single suspect, leading to the arrest.

Burglarized locations include:

- *Lindsey Hopkins Technical College (750 NW 20 Street)*
- *Miami Dade College – Medical Campus (950 NW 20 Street)*
- *Miami Dade College – Wolfson Campus (500 NE 2 Avenue)*
- *Atlantis University (1011 NW Sunnybrook Road)*

This arrest was made possible through the collaborative efforts of officers and detectives from the Downtown, Allapattah, and Overtown areas. The investigation remains ongoing, and authorities are reviewing additional cases for possible connections.

Message from Chief Manuel Morales.

"The Miami Police Department remains steadfast in its commitment to safeguarding our community and upholding public trust. The recent arrest tied to school and campus burglaries underscores the dedication and diligence of our officers and detectives in pursuing those who threaten our safety. Their tireless efforts send a clear message: criminal activity targeting our neighborhoods will not go unchecked".
